Genesis 1:1

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."

KJV

REFLECT

Begin where God begins — with Him.

complete

DAY 2

Psalms 23:1

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."

KJV

REFLECT

Today, name one need He has already met.

complete

DAY 3

Proverbs 3:5-6

"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths."

KJV

REFLECT

Surrender one decision to God before noon.

complete

DAY 4

Isaiah 41:10

"Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee."

KJV

REFLECT

Where is fear loud? Pray this verse over it.

DAY 5

Philippians 4:13

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

KJV

REFLECT

Christ — not willpower — is your source.

complete

DAY 6

Jeremiah 29:11

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."

KJV

REFLECT

Trust the Author of your story today.

complete

DAY 7

Psalm 46:10

"Be still, and know that I am God."

KJV

REFLECT

Take five silent minutes. Just be.

complete

DAY 8

Romans 8:28

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose."

KJV

REFLECT

Even this hard thing — God is at work.

complete

DAY 9

Matthew 11:28

"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

KJV

REFLECT

Bring one heavy thing to Jesus today.

complete

DAY 10

Lamentations 3:22-23

"It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed... They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness."

KJV

REFLECT

Yesterday's failures do not define today.

complete

DAY 11

Psalm 119:105

"Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

KJV

REFLECT

Read one chapter of Scripture today.

complete

DAY 12

John 3:16

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

KJV

REFLECT

You are deeply, eternally loved.

complete

DAY 13

Psalm 139:14

"I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made."

KJV

REFLECT

Speak this verse over yourself today.

complete

DAY 14

Ephesians 2:8-9

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."

KJV

REFLECT

Salvation is gift, not wage. Receive it.

complete

DAY 15

2 Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

KJV

REFLECT

What old thing is God making new in you?

complete

DAY 16

Psalm 34:18

"The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit."

KJV

REFLECT

He is closer than your sorrow.

complete

DAY 17

Isaiah 40:31

"But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles."

KJV

REFLECT

Waiting is not wasted time.

complete

DAY 18

Galatians 5:22-23

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance."

KJV

REFLECT

Which fruit do you most need today?

complete

DAY 19

1 Corinthians 13:4-5

"Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not... is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil."

KJV

REFLECT

Where can love show up today?

complete

DAY 20

James 1:5

"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him."

KJV

REFLECT

Ask God for wisdom in one situation.

complete

DAY 21

Psalm 27:1

"The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?"

KJV

REFLECT

Name a fear. Then name your God.

complete

DAY 22

Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

KJV

REFLECT

Faith acts before it sees.

complete

DAY 23

Matthew 6:33

"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

KJV

REFLECT

Re-order one priority around Christ.

complete

DAY 24

Psalm 51:10

"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."

KJV

REFLECT

Pray this verse slowly, three times.

complete

DAY 25

Romans 12:2

"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind."

KJV

REFLECT

Replace one cultural lie with God's truth.

complete

DAY 26

Joshua 1:9

"Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid... for the Lord thy God is with thee."

KJV

REFLECT

Step into the courage He has commanded.

complete

DAY 27

Psalm 19:14

"Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord."

KJV

REFLECT

Guard your words today.

complete

DAY 28

Matthew 28:19-20

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations... and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world."

KJV

REFLECT

Who needs to hear about Jesus from you?

complete

DAY 29

Philippians 4:6-7

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be known unto God."

KJV

REFLECT

Replace one worry with one prayer.

complete

DAY 30

Revelation 21:4

"And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying."

KJV

REFLECT

The end of the journey: His presence forever.
