

Holy Week

Eight days of Scripture from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday

Walk with Jesus through the most important week in human history. Each day's reading takes 10-15 minutes -- read it in the morning or as a family at dinner.

- PALM SUNDAY**
Matthew 21:1-11
The triumphal entry into Jerusalem -- the King arrives on a donkey.

- HOLY MONDAY**
Matthew 21:12-22; Mark 11:12-19
Jesus cleanses the temple and curses the fig tree.

- HOLY TUESDAY**
Matthew 21:23 -- 25:46
A long day of teaching: parables, woes, and the Olivet Discourse.

- HOLY WEDNESDAY**
Matthew 26:1-16
The plot to kill Jesus; Mary anoints Him; Judas agrees to betray.

- MAUNDY THURSDAY**
Luke 22:7-46; John 13 -- 17
The Last Supper, the new commandment, the high-priestly prayer, Gethsemane.

- GOOD FRIDAY**
John 18 -- 19; Luke 23
The arrest, trials, crucifixion, and burial of Jesus Christ.

- HOLY SATURDAY**
Matthew 27:57-66
The tomb is sealed and guarded. Heaven is silent. The waiting day.

- RESURRECTION SUNDAY**
Matthew 28; Luke 24; John 20 -- 21
He is not here, for He is risen. The Lord is risen indeed.
