A simple framework for engaging -- and remembering -- Sunday's sermon (KJV)

The best sermon in the world fades by Tuesday if it isn't captured. This template gives you a structured page for each Sunday: passage, main point, key cross-references, personal application, and a one-line prayer to carry into the week.

How to use this template

- Fill in the date, preacher, and main passage at the top during the welcome.
- Write the main point in one sentence -- pastors usually repeat it; listen for it.
- Capture two or three key supporting verses. Don't try to write everything.
- End with one application and one short prayer. Re-read on Wednesday.
